Disability Declaration

The Dayle McIntosh Center (DMC) is an independent living center and 501(c)(3) located in Orange County, California. The state and federal funding requirements for the operation of centers for independent living require consumer-control in all areas of operation. Specifically, the majority or at least 51% of the governing board, leadership, and staff must be comprised of individuals with disabilities.

An individual with a disability is defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act as a person who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, a person who has a history or record of such impairment, or a person who is perceived by others as having such impairment. DMC will not require or request medical documentation regarding a disability or diagnosis.

The primary entities which fund the center require that information on staff and board composition be reported on an annual basis. Personal information is kept confidential and is never included with such statistical reporting.
