WHAT YOUTH GAIN THROUGH OUR PRE-ETS SERVICES

Self-Advocacy Instruction

Youth learn to request accommodations, understand workplace rights, communicate effectively, and build independence.

Job Exploration Counseling

Youth discover career pathways aligned with their strengths, interests, and today's workforce needs, helping them make informed decisions about their future.

Workplace Readiness Training

Training focuses on communication, problem-solving, transportation skills, time management, and workplace expectations.

Postsecondary Education & Training Counseling

Youth learn about college, vocational training, certifications, and how to successfully access disability supports after high school.

Work-Based Learning Experiences

Participants gain hands-on experience in real and simulated work environments, building confidence, independence, and professional skills.
