DMC's Community Transition Program supports qualifying individuals to safely move out of skilled nursing facilities, long term care, or other institutionalized settings to live independently in the community.

DMC can help you access:

- Accessible housing vouchers (ages 18-61 only)
- IHSS and caregiving services
- Home modifications (grab bars, ramps, stair lifts)
- Household items and furnishings
- Durable Medical Equipment (walkers, wheelchairs, scooters)
- Other training and resources for independent living

NON-ELDERLY DISABLED (NED) VOUCHER

The NED Voucher provides affordable housing for younger long-term care residents who want to live independently in the community.



To be eligible for the voucher, residents must:

- Be between 18 and 61 years old
- Have a disability or diagnosis (physical, mental, emotional, or other)
- Live in a long-term care facility for at least 90 consecutive days
- Have Medi-Cal health insurance
- Be able to transition safely to the community with appropriate supports
